Eligibility requirements for Lab Lift



Physical within the last 18 months that includes complete blood work.



Ages 20-50, applying for up to \$4 million in coverage.



Ages 51-60, applying for up to \$2 million in coverage.

Expect speed and inclusivity

The Lab Lift program includes process automation to speed up cases and cover more people. These below examples are real-life case studies with eligible applicants where exams and labs were replaced with either an EHR or APS.



Case 1: John


- · 60-year-old male
- Applying for \$250,000
- · History of sleep apnea and high blood pressure

Underwriting outcome:

- · Approved in 16 days without exam or labs
- Table 2

No additional work or information required.

Eligibility for Lab Lift is determined by date of last physician visit and blood work. If not qualified, a paramed exam will be ordered.



Case 2: Samantha

- · 40-year-old female
- Applying for \$1.5 million
- History of hypertension and gestational diabetes

Underwriting outcome:

- · Approved in 20 days without exam or labs
